## Grande Prairie Public Hearing Cancelled due to Bad Weather

*Edmonton* – A freezing rain warning issued this afternoon by Environment Canada for the Peace River, Wabasca and Grande Prairie regions has made it unsafe to travel resulting in a cancellation of this evening's scheduled Electoral Boundaries Commission public hearing in Grande Prairie.

The Commission expressly regrets the cancellation of the hearing to take place Sandman Hotel in Grande Prairie at 7 p.m. and wants to encourage Albertans to take part by providing a written submission by February 8, 2017.

The Commission began its public consultation in Edmonton on Monday and has travelled to Fort McMurray and Peace River. The Commission will travel to Red Deer on Friday. In total the commission plans to visit 14 communities during the months of January and February.
