Correction Notice to the Interim Report to the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta

Page 70 of the *Proposed Electoral Division Areas, Boundaries, and Names for Alberta, Interim Report to the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, May 2017* contained an error.

All electronic versions of the report are accurate, however, the 300 printed and bound copies, including those tabled in the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, May 25, inadvertently contained an omission of the following paragraph which should appear at the top of page 70, falling under the sub heading “Variances”:

To this point on variances, in the Charlottetown (City) vs Prince Edward Island (1998) case, the majority of the Court concluded that the variances were well within the tolerances accepted by McLachlin. In the Saskatchewan Reference “there is considerable acceptance in Canada for a variance of + /- 25%.”

The Commission looks forward to hearing from the public on the proposed changes in the Interim Report.
